## **Platinum Jubilee Trees**

## So.... When Are We Planting Them?....

To commemorate the Platinum Jubilee the Parish Council will be providing four Himalayan birch trees, which will be planted at four different locations in the Parish and nurtured and looked after by local volunteer groups. Shevington in Bloom (who originally put the suggestion forward) will take responsibility for the tree in Shevington Memorial Garden.

In addition to this the Parish Council have been licenced to plant the other three trees on land belonging to Wigan Council. So, Appley Bridge in Bloom will take responsibility for the tree to be planted on the green open space beside Woodnook Road shops in Shevington Vale, and Shevington Moor in Bloom will look after the one at Whiteacre Park. Crooke Village Residents Association will be collecting all of the trees from the supplier in Southport and planting and looking after the tree intended for Crooke Village Green.

Jubilee tree planting has now been paused nationally until October, so the planting will take place in the Autumn. The Parish Council hope to hold formal ceremonies to mark the planting then, so – for more news – watch this space!
