Proclaiming the Accession of King Charles III

The Accession Council met at St James's Palace in London on Saturday, 10 September. Made up of Privy Counsellors (which include the prime minister, the leader of the opposition and members of the Royal Family), Great Officers of State, the Lord Mayor of London, Realm High Commissioners and senior civil servants, it only convenes on the death of the monarch.

The Council derives from Saxon times and oversees the formal proclamation of the heir to the throne becoming King or Queen.

After the new King Charles III had met with the Council the Garter King of Arms, Earl Marshal, officers and sergeants of arms gathered on the balcony above Friary Court at St James's Palace and read the proclamation. Straight afterwards it was read at the Royal Exchange in the City of London - in the presence of the Lord Mayor of London.

Subsequent readings followed in Edinburgh, Cardiff, Belfast and locations across the Commonwealth at different times on the Sunday. The readings were then cascaded down to other cities and towns and finally to civil parishes. Some 70 residents witnessed
